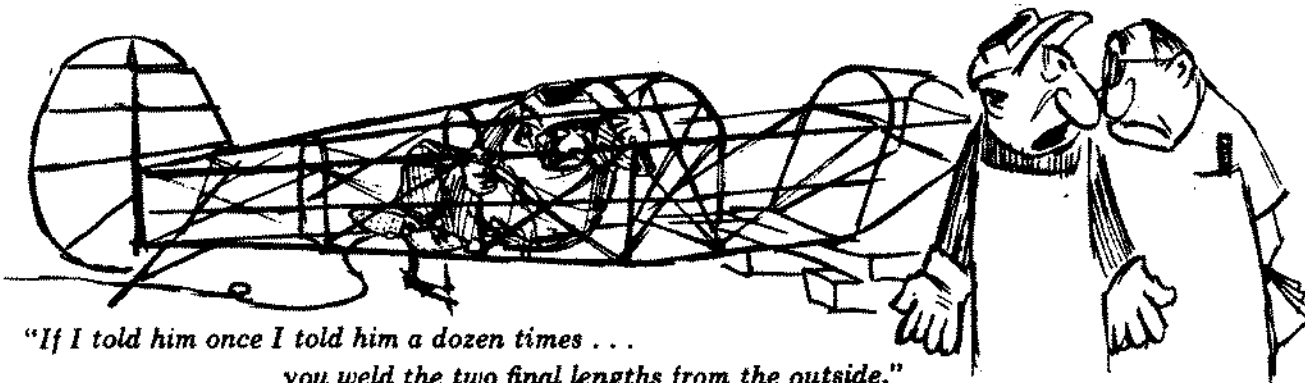
Monday 1st April, 7.30pm. Ray Ovelgonne will present the programme, come and find out what it is!
