After that you can fly off to Frankfurt Airport, for the fun & games there!

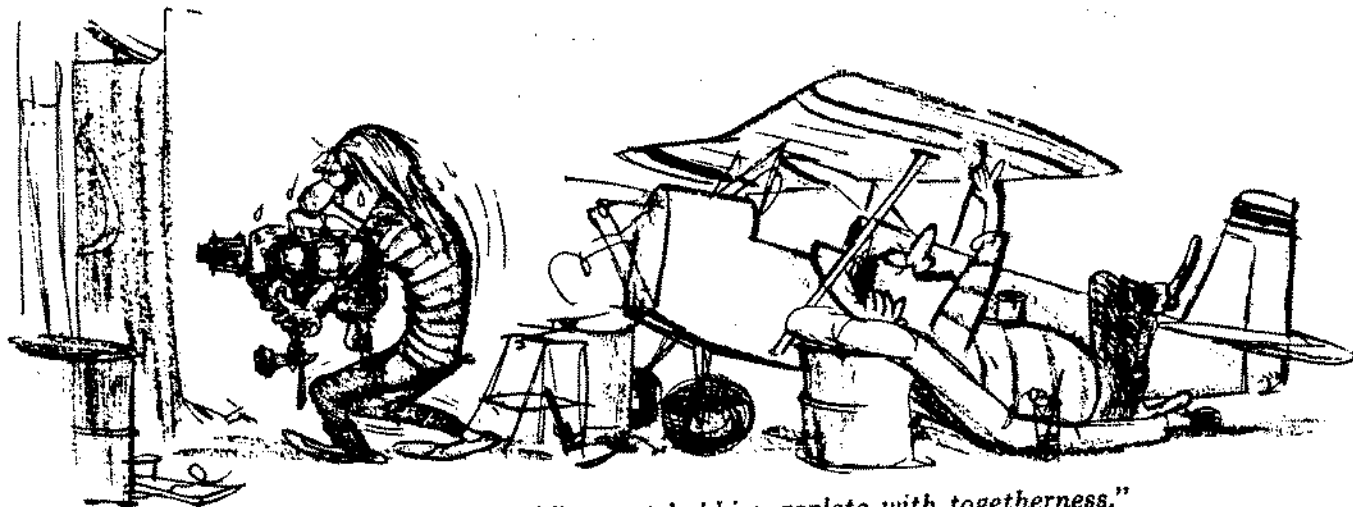
Next Meeting
