NEXT MEETING

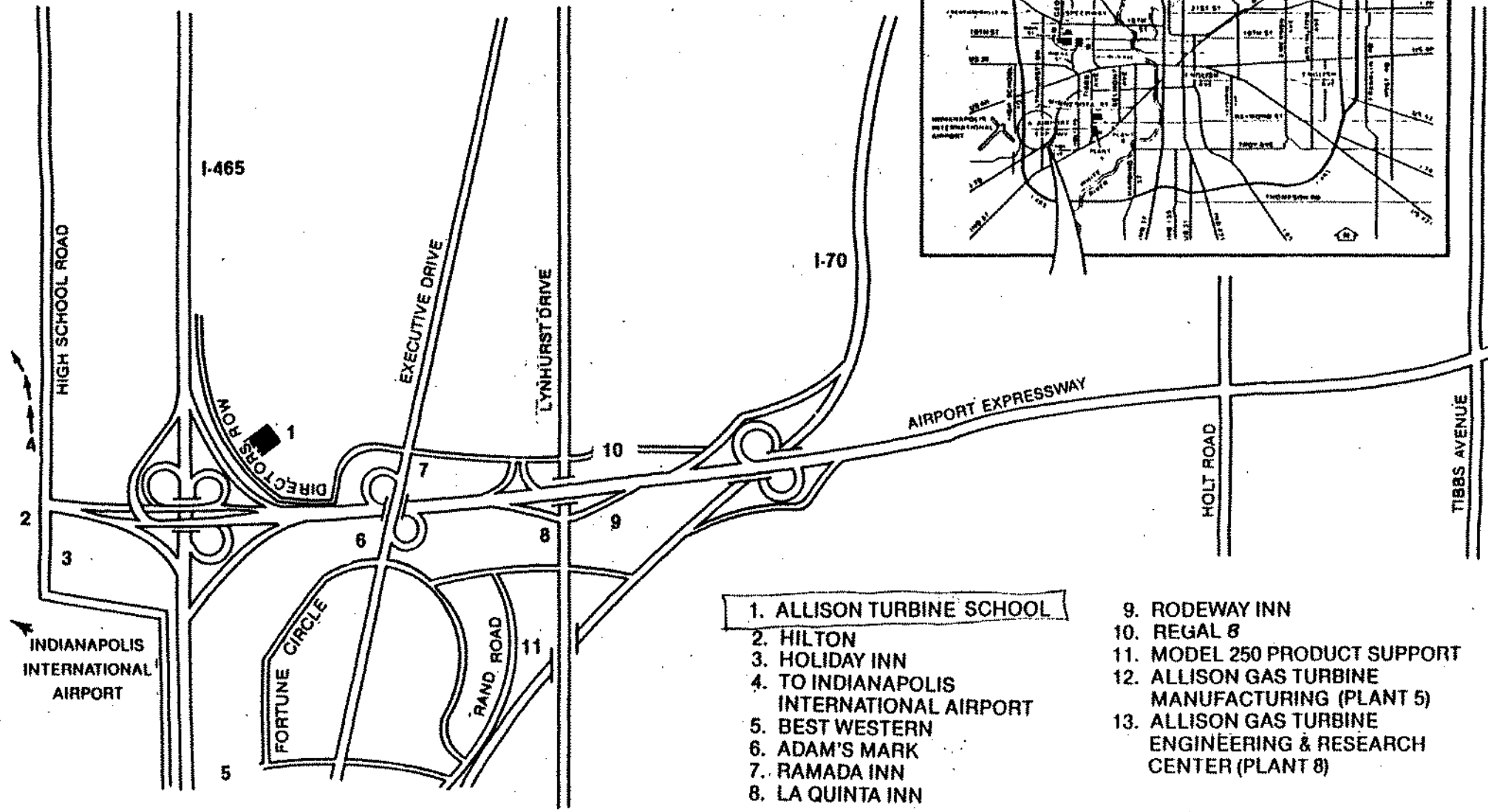
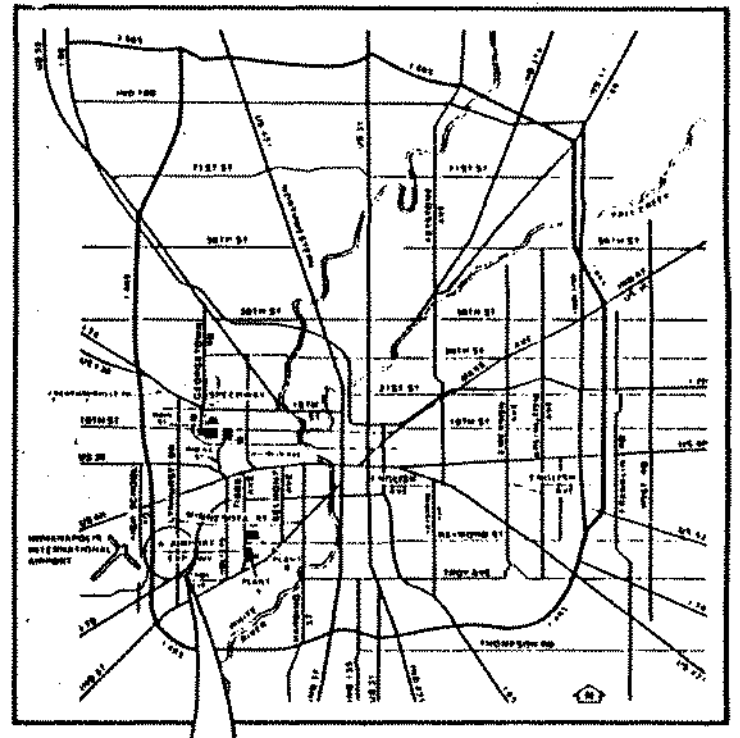
