Our next meeting is scheduled for Monday, December 5, 1988. Don Dole will present the program. When asked about the program, he said,

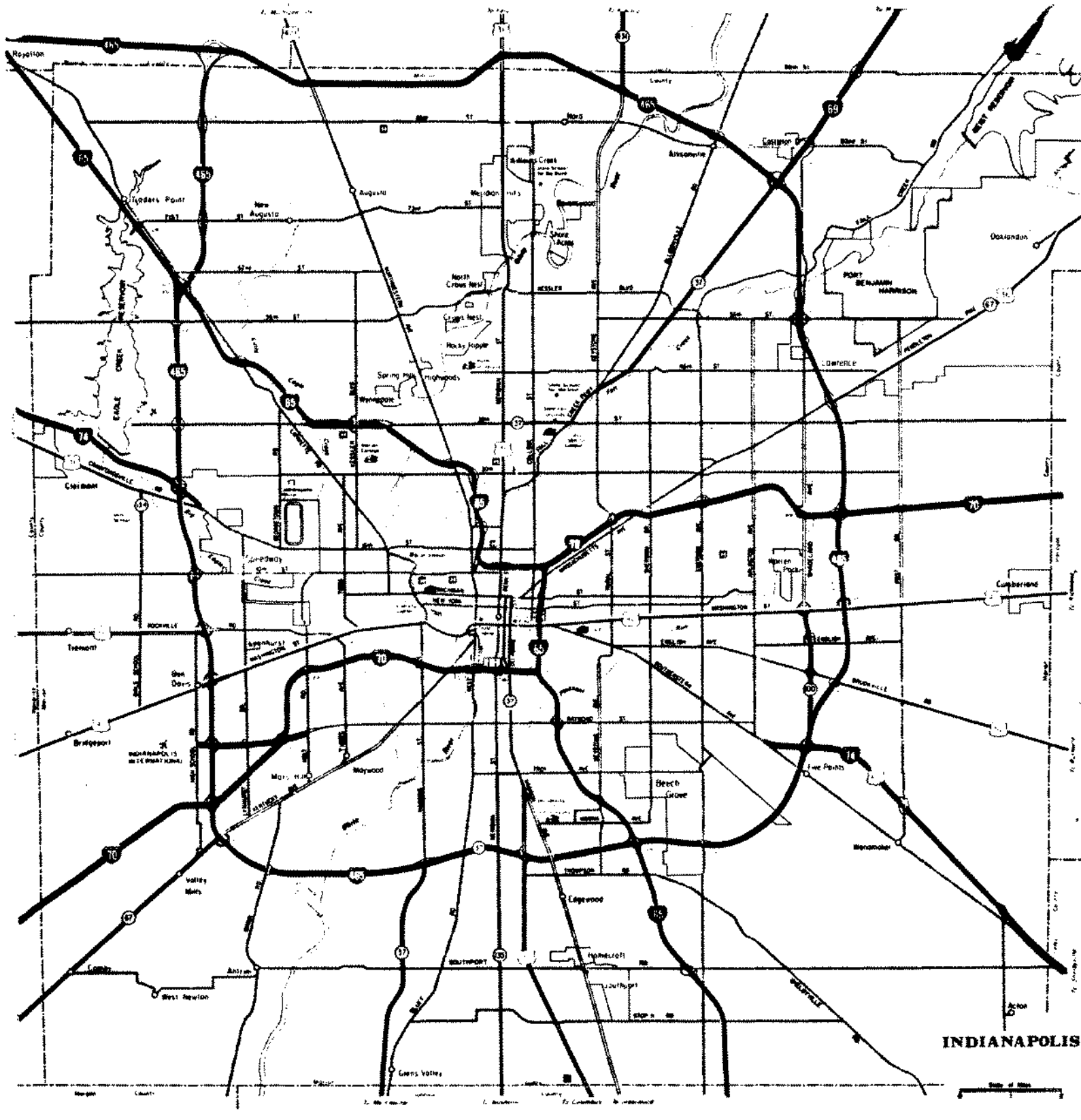
"It'll be a good one!"
