### **Secretary's Report:**

### **Treasurer's report:**

We currently have all bills paid and have approximately \$4,000.00 in the account. We did not have any expense for the Air Academy this year. The pancake breakfast was very successful.

### **New Business:**

**Air Academy** – we have two reservations for next year. If you know someone who is interested, names must be submitted and applications complete by March 1<sup>st</sup>. The age groups are 12-13, 14-15, 16-18. The student must submit a letter explaining why they would like to attend and is required to give a presentation when they return.

**BBQ** – scheduled for Sunday the 7<sup>th</sup>. We are in need of many individuals to volunteer. Please come to the October 1<sup>st</sup> meeting ready to sign up as a volunteer. Please also encourage wives to assist with the BBQ.

We have tried to get information from Waste Management regarding port-o-pots but have had no response. In addition to the port-o-pots, it was recommended that we try to obtain a couple of the wash stations similar to what was available at the Air Show. Don will check with the City of Noblesville. It is believed that the cost is \$85.00 for three days. We are not sure of the cost of the wash station.

Lynn will prepare the menu and provide the meat. He will also provide bottled water.

Don will provide picnic table, ice and advertisement.

The planned menu is chicken quarters, BBQ, hamburgers and hot dogs. Timm McNott may be available to cook.

Don will provide two cakes.

Everyone should plan to bring a dessert.

If possible please ask all wives to help serve.

We need to push for attendance at the next meeting and have a sign up roster.

Crowd control will be very important. During the pancake breakfast a few people parked at the end of the runway. We will need car parkers. Don will make parking signs.

John will check at Sheridan to see if anyone is interested in flying. If so, he will have them send EAA number to Jeff.

All volunteers need to be at Muncie at 8:00AM for PFB and details on the pattern.

Dave will set up a weather line.

Chapter equipment – there is a non-member interested in borrowing the scales owned by the chapter. It was decided that you must be a chapter member to borrow equipment.
